We interviewed Dr. The on July 14, 1993, and asked him about any affiliation with or benefit derived by him from the one of Dr. stated that, in 1989, the stated gallery received a grant from the was one of many photography exhibits. He stated that though he was one of many photographers invited by the gallery to participate, he received no financial benefit from the further stated that he has sold photographs at exhibits, but that there was no contact between him and the at that time nor since. Regarding the taking of photographs during work hours, Dr. denied ever doing so, and stated that he had taken photographs while on travel for NSF, but all were taken either in the evenings or on weekends.

As no violations were found, this case is closed.
