

Notes on OIG-90-3101

These are the two individuals who called the case to our attention. I told [REDACTED], as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] that we had looked into the matter and had resolved it appropriately with [REDACTED]. I also told her that I would speak with [REDACTED]

I told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had apologized for copying material from [REDACTED] paper in his proposal, and that [REDACTED] now understands that this is an undesirable practice. I emphasized that I had not told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was aware of the case. [REDACTED] felt that [REDACTED] is probably a young person who does not fully understand some scientific practices.

I told both of them that my conversations with them were informal and that OIG dealt with these cases confidentially. I also told them that we now consider the matter to be closed and will not attempt to have a penalty imposed on [REDACTED]. Both were satisfied with the outcome of the case.
