OIG asked the assistance of in analyzing this reply. By this time the proposal had been declined for technical reasons and she had no further involvement with it. Her reply supported the conclusion that should have given more credit for their informal communications in his proposal, but that there was no evidence of misconduct. This conclusion was communicated to in a letter (dated ) and to in a phone call.
