CLOSEOUT MEMORANDUM

As part of a proactive review, we investigated a university and its Principal Investigators (PI) who did not disclose foreign-funded projects or organizational affiliations in their NSF proposals. As part of this multi-agency investigation, we reviewed foreign contracts, awards, and restricted gifts entered into or accepted by the university over the past 5 years. We found that the university was not in compliance with NSF's Proposal & Award Policies & Procedures Guide requirement that PIs and Co-PIs disclose all forms of current and pending sources of funding, both foreign and domestic. We also identified a PI who was employed at a foreign university and received foreign research funding, neither of which was disclosed to NSF nor other federal agencies, as required. As a result of our findings and based on our recommendation, NSF suspended 14 awards associated with the investigation.

We referred the matter to the Department of Justice. As part of a civil settlement agreement, the university agreed to pay over \$1.9 million to resolve False Claims Act liability, and to work with NSF to address issues identified throughout the investigation.

This case has been *closed*, and no further action will be taken.
