Pursuant to the *Government Charge Card Abuse Prevention Act of 2012* and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Memorandum 13-21, Inspectors General are required to report to the Director of OMB the agency's progress in implementing audit recommendations related to Government charge cards.

As of September 30, 2018, there were no outstanding audit recommendations for purchase cards for the National Science Foundation (NSF). We issued our last purchase card audit report in January 2014.

As of September 30, 2018, there was no outstanding audit recommendations for travel cards for NSF. We issued our last travel card audit report in August 2015.

Regarding the semi-annual Joint Purchase Card Violation Report, we are not submitting a report because NSF's Fiscal Year 2018 purchase card activity was less than \$10 million.
